













The last date for abstract submission is **10**th **January 2026**.

General Guidelines

- Registration for the conference is mandatory to submit an abstract.
- All abstracts initially will be considered for E-Poster presentation on Day 1 out of which Top 6 will be selected for Oral Presentation on Day 2.
- Please keep the e-poster and a 10-slide PPT ready in advance to avoid last-minute preparation, so that if selected, you can present on Day 2 during the oral presentation session.
- Title of your Abstract should be less than 25 words.
- The Abstract should be less than 350 words excluding the title.
- The abstract should contain Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results & Discussion/Conclusion. (Introduction, Case Details and Discussion for Case Reports)
- The detailed guidelines of abstract submissions and presentation is given on the website.
